Application Must Include:

- Map depicting the area where the proposed earth work is to occur.
- List of primary highway, streets or other public way within one mile of the boundaries of the property upon which the earth work will occur and along which material excavated or removed shall be transported in normal operations.
- Specifications of the following: using appropriate maps, photographs and surveys:
 - Proposed grading plan
 - Proposed stock pile
 - Physical relationship of proposed designated site to the community and existing development
 - Site topography and natural features including the location of water courses and water bodies.
 - A description and quantity of material to be excavated.
 - The depth of water tables throughout the area.
 - The location and depth of wells and buried garbage, water and fill.
 - The purpose of the operation.
 - The estimated time required to complete the operation.
 - The proposed months of the year during which the operation would take place and the proposed hours of the day during which the operation would take place.
 - A tree survey indicating the location and types of all trees over six (6) inches in diameter. In heavily wooded areas only the boundaries of the tree areas must be indicated on the survey.
 - Any proposals for screening of the operation.
 - The plan of the operation including the processing, nature of the processing and equipment, the location of any plant and the source of water, as well as proposed method of disposal of water or re-use.
 - Plans for drainage, erosion control, sedimentation and dust control.
 - A restoration plan providing for the orderly and continuing restoration of all disturbed land to a condition equal to or better than that which existed prior to the earth work.
 - A statement identifying the applicant's intent regarding response to complaints and resolving of conflict that may arise as a result of complaints.
 - An environmental assessment worksheet if required by the City.
 - A wetland alteration permit if required.
- Any additional written or graphic data required by the City Administrator.
- Please see Sec.36-9 or the City Code that is attached for all information regarding regulations and limitation on excavating, mining, filling, & grading.
